In the 3rd quarter of 2012 up to present, PAMA joined the establishment of Junior PAMA organizations as a partner in the promotion and uplifting the management accounting profession, PAMA assists the students in their journey towards being successful management accounting professionals and early exposure to the interaction with AMAP professionals. Mergers, acquisition and divestiture fundamentals; international managerial finance; ethical issues for financial management professionals.
